- 1. The subject corresponds to the scope of the journal.
- 2. The style of writing corresponds to the journal style.
- 3. Article title is appropriate and reflects the content.
- 4. Tables and figures are informative and supportive of the text.
- 5. Is the literature stated in the text relevant and up-to-date?
- 6. Are the references listed according to journal recommendations?
- 7. Abstract is adequately structured and contains all the necessary information (relevant results and conclusions).
- 8. Manuscript contains clearly defined hypothesis, stated in Introduction.
- 9. The methods and measurements applied are adequate.
- 10. The study included a sufficient number of subjects (samples).
- 11. The type of sampling and all applied methods are described in detail, allowing an interested reader to duplicate them.
- 12. Has the study been approved by a competent ethics committee?
- 13. Statistical methods have been applied adequately.
- 14. Results of the study are presented and interpreted correctly.
- 15. Is discussion appropriate and coherent? Are results in the discussion section interpreted in relation to those in current literature?
- 16. Have study limitations been clearly identified?
- 17. All abbreviations are written correctly and explained.
- 18. Conclusions are consistent with the results .
